Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) TRAINEE

Definition: A CERT Trainee is a qualified person that has:

1. completed an Agency Application which has been approved by the Agency Department Head or his/her designee, AND
2. completed a CERT Training Application which has been approved by the CERT Program Manager, AND
3. completed FEMA IS-317 "Introduction to CERT" online within 30 days of approval of the CERT Training Application

A CERT TRAINEE in the Calaveras Emergency Response Team Program sponsored by the Calaveras Citizen Corps Council and recognized by a sponsoring agency may participate in all activities he/she is qualified to undertake as a CERT TRAINEE under the following conditions and stipulations:

1. TRAINEE must complete a CERT Basic Academy within 395 days of an approved application by a Sponsoring Agency
2. A TRAINEE may be issued CERT Personal Protective Equipment that will remain the property of the Calaveras Emergency Response Team Program until such time the Trainee completes the CERT Basic Academy when it will become the property of the TRAINEE
3. A TRAINEE may NOT be counted as a member of any CERT in any event (training or otherwise) where there is less than 2 CERT Members in attendance
4. A TRAINEE must be under the direct supervision (line of sight) of the immediate CERT Lead assigned to that specific event
5. A TRAINEE will be issued identification identifying him/her as a CERT TRAINEE for the Agency sponsoring the TRAINEE
